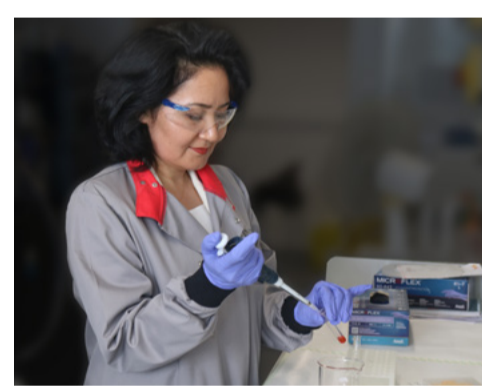
12-month internships starting 15 June 2026
